Resident Firefighter/EMT Position

The City of North Pole is accepting applications for the position of Resident Firefighter.

Qualifications: Minimum requirements are a current CPR certification and valid Alaska Driver's License. Firefighting/EMS experience is preferred but not required. Residents must be 19 years of age or older.

Housing: Each Resident Firefighter will be assigned to a dorm room inside of our Annex building for occupancy during off shift days, dorm rooms may be shared with one additional roommate that would be assigned to offsetting shifts.

Shift Assignments: Each resident firefighter will be assigned to one of three shifts. When the assigned shift is on duty, the resident firefighter will be required to spend the 24-hour shift in the fire station with the duty crew rather than in the resident dorms. Absence from shift to attend School or Work will be given during the shift and will be pre-coordinated with the shift officer.

Shift Schedule: Resident Firefighters will work the same 24-hour shift schedule our career staff member work with shift change conducted at 0800hrs. Schedule has an average of 10 shifts worked per month.

The North Pole Fire Department Resident Firefighter program is ideal for personnel of all experience and backgrounds. The Fire Department provides a comfortable place to live while serving the community of North Pole, building individual experience, certification and education. College students enjoy off campus dorms that provide valuable experience working with an emergency response agency while obtaining a formal education. The combination of experience and formal education is a key to being qualified and capable of permanent employment with Fire Departments all around the Country.
