**A RESOLUTION OF THE OKANOGAN COUNTY TRANSIT AUTHORITY
AUTHORIZING EMPLOYEES TO PAY CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE
PUBLIC EMPLOYEE RETIREMENT SYSTEM OVER TWO PAY PERIODS**

WHEREAS, the Okanogan County Transit Authority ("OCTA") Board passed Resolution 2015-01 at its regular meeting on January 12, 2015, authorizing and approving eligible employees to participate in the Washington Public Employees Retirement System ("PERS"), as allowed by RCW 41.40.060; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2015-01 established that the PERS membership for OCTA employees shall begin on October 1, 2015; and


WHEREAS, the retroactive application of the membership resulted in requiring OCTA and OCTA employees to pay their contributions from the time of eligibility on October 1, 2014, until the first reporting period on February 28, 2015; and

WHEREAS, OCTA is desirous of allowing OCTA employees to pay these retroactive contributions owed by deductions from their payroll over the next successive two pay periods beginning on March 1, 2015.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of OCTA as follows:


The Board does hereby authorize OCTA employees to pay retroactive contributions made for such OCTA employees through payroll deductions over the next successive two pay periods beginning March 1, 2015.
