

RESOLUTION 2015- 30

**A RESOLUTION OF THE OKANOGAN COUNTY TRANSIT
AUTHORITY ADOPTING RULES OF CONDUCT FOR TRANSIT
VEHICLES, FACILITIES AND PROPERTIES.**

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Okanogan County Transit Authority ("OCTA") to adopt certain rules to regulate conduct occurring on OCTA transit vehicles and within or upon facilities and properties, in connection with OCTA's provision of public transportation services; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors ("Board") of OCTA is desirous of adopting such rules of conduct that govern transit vehicles, facilities and properties that provide public transportation services for the orderly, safe and secure use of OCTA vehicles, facilities and properties.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of OCTA does hereby resolve as follows:

SECTION 1 - APPROVAL AND ADOPTION. The Board of OCTA does hereby approve and adopt the Okanogan County Transit Authority Rules of Conduct for Transit Vehicles, Facilities and Properties attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and incorporated herein as though fully set forth.

SECTION 2 - EFFECTIVE DATE. Such Rules of Conduct referenced in Section 1 above shall be effective immediately upon adoption by the Board.
