

RESOLUTION 2016-11

A RESOLUTION OF THE OKANOGAN COUNTY TRANSIT AUTHORITY ESTABLISHING FARE RATES FOR CASH PAYMENT AT THE TIME OF BUS BOARDING AND AUTHORIZING THE CONTINUED MAINTENANCE OF AN ACCOUNT TO RECEIVE CREDIT /DEBIT CARD PAYMENTS FOR FARE PASSES SOLD ON LINE OR IN THE TRANSIT OFFICE.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors ("Board") of the Okanogan County Transit Authority ("OCTA") by Resolution No. 22 dated July 13, 2015 established fares for the Omak-Okanogan shuttle and authorized the established of an account to receive credit/ debit card payments for prepaid fare passes; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to repeal Resolution No. 22 and establish fares for OCTA, to become effective July 1, 2016.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board as follows:

1. The Board does hereby approve and establish the following fares:
 - a. Single zone of travel – \$1.00 cash per boarding;
 - b. Monthly unlimited use fare pass for single zone of travel – \$3000

For the purposes of this Resolution, "single zone of travel" shall mean the following routes:

North Methow
South Methow
Twisp-Okanogan Connector
North Okanogan
Mid Okanogan
South Okanogan
Omak-Okanogan Shuttle

- c. Two zone of travel – \$2.00 cash(\$1.00 for each zone);
- d. Monthly unlimited use fare pass for two zone of travel –\$6000

For the purposes of this Resolution, "two zones of travel" shall include the following routes:

North Methow plus South Methow
North Methow plus Twisp-Okanogan Connector
Twisp-Okanogan Connector plus Mid Okanogan
Twisp-Okanogan Connector plus Omak-Okanogan Shuttle
Twisp-Okanogan Connector plus South Okanogan
South Methow plus South Okanogan
Mid Okanogan plus Omak-Okanogan Shuttle
North Okanogan plus Mid Okanogan
South Okanogan plus Omak-Okanogan Shuttle
OR any other 2 contiguous routes

e. An unlimited monthly pass to ride anywhere in the system (multiple zones) – \$90.00.

Veterans shall receive a discount of 50% off a regular fare or pass cost.

2. The Board also authorizes periodic deviation from the established fares for specific days or events, upon prior approval in advance by the Board.

3. OCTA is authorized to continue the maintenance of a separate account to receive credit/debit card payments for any fares or passes. Such account shall be at the same financial institution authorized by the Board as a depository of funds for OCTA.

4. This Resolution shall become effective on July 1, 2016.

5. Resolution No. 22 adopted by the Board on July 13, 2015, is hereby repealed, effective July 1, 2016.
