

**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-01**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE OKANOGAN COUNTY  
TRANSIT AUTHORITY APPROVING AND ADOPTING  
AN EXPOSURE CONTROL PLAN REGARDING  
OCCUPATIONAL EXPOSURE TO BLOODBORNE  
PATHOGENS.**

**WHEREAS**, the staff of the Okanogan County Transit Authority ("OCTA") have developed an Exposure Control Plan to eliminate or minimize occupational exposure to bloodborne pathogens in accordance with OSHA Standard 29 CFR 1910.1030, "Occupational Exposure to Bloodborne Pathogens"; and

**WHEREAS**, the OCTA Board of Directors have reviewed the Exposure Control Plan and are desirous of adopting such Plan to eliminate or minimize occupational exposure to bloodborne pathogens.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Directors of OCTA as follows:

**1. Approval of Exposure Control Plan.** The Board of Directors of OCTA does hereby approve the Exposure Control Plan attached hereto and incorporated herein as though fully set forth.

**2. Effective Date.** The implementation of the Exposure Control Plan shall be effective as of the date of the passage of this Resolution.
