

**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-02**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE OKANOGAN COUNTY TRANSIT AUTHORITY ADOPTING A NEW POLICY NO. 601B - HEPATITIS B VACCINATION, OF THE OKANOGAN COUNTY TRANSIT AUTHORITY POLICY AND PROCEDURE MANUAL.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Directors, hereinafter "Board", of the Okanogan County Transit Authority, hereinafter "OCTA", has adopted an Exposure Control Plan designed to eliminate or minimize occupational exposure to bloodborne pathogens; and

**WHEREAS**, a portion of the Exposure Control Plan addresses Hepatitis B vaccination; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board desires to adopt a new Policy No. 601B to the OCTA Policy and Procedure Manual which addresses Hepatitis B vaccination.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of OCTA as follows:

**Section 1.** The Board does hereby approve and adopt Policy No. 601B -Hepatitis B Vaccination, to be added to the OCTA Policy and Procedure Manual, and such Policy 601B is attached hereto and incorporated herein as though fully set forth.

**Section 2.** All existing employees and future employees of OCTA shall receive a copy of Policy No. 601B - Hepatitis B Vaccination, and shall sign an acknowledgment indicating that they have received such copy and agree to abide by such as a condition of employment by OCTA.
