

**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-13**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE OKANOGAN COUNTY TRANSIT AUTHORITY  
BOARD OF DIRECTORS REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 2020-19.**

**WHEREAS**, on September 16, 2020, the Okanogan County Transit Authority ("OCTA") Board of Directors ("Board") adopted Resolution No. 2020-19, which authorized the General Manager of OCTA to extend such amounts of emergency paid sick leave, at their sole discretion, as they believed necessary to reduce the risk of transmission of COVID-19 in the OCTA workplace; and

**WHEREAS**, such authorization was in addition to the COVID-19 paid sick leave entitlement allowed to eligible employees under Section 2.3 of Resolution No. 2020-07; and

**WHEREAS**, the OCTA Board has determined that it is no longer necessary to authorize the General Manager to extend such amounts of emergency paid sick leave, which is in addition to paid sick leave entitlement allowed to eligible employees under Section 2.3 of Resolution No. 2020-07.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the OCTA Board as follows:


**Section 1 - Repealer.** Resolution No. 2020-19 shall be repealed in its entirety.

**Section 2 - Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective on the date of execution herein.

**Section 3 - Terms and Conditions.** All other terms and conditions of Resolution No. 2020-07 shall remain in full force and effect.
