Pecan Grove Marina/ Cox Family Properties Discussion:

The Board discussed Pecan Grove Marina request of the Pamlico County Board of Commissioners to apply for a grant to dredge the "Shop Gut Channel". Mr. John Cox was present to answer any questions. County Manager Mark Brewington mentioned that there have been changes to the regulations and the 8 requirements would have to be met to be considered for the grant. Mr. Cox mentioned since the last dredging in 2017, the 1600 ft "Shop Gut" channel has encountered many storms and climate change. As a result, shoaling has become an issue making it difficult to sustain a consistent depth of 8 feet, as the permit requires. County Manager Mark Brewington mentioned there would have to be a resolution

prepared if approved by the Board.

On a motion made by Commissioner Ollison and seconded by Commissioner Heath, the following resolution was approved by a vote of 5:2 (Nay: Commissioner Bohmert and Riggs).

BE IT RESOLVED, the request from Pecan Grove Marina/Cox Family Properties LLC to Pamlico County Board of Commissioners for Pamlico County to apply for a grant to dredge the “Shop Gut Channel”, is hereby approved. [25-26-112]

The Board discussed the Sheriff’s Office request to add a new Task Force Officer Position. Sheriff Chris Davis was present to answer any questions. Sheriff Chris Davis mentioned this is a position that will be attached to a newly formed multi-county drug task force including Craven, Carteret, and Pamlico counties. Finance Officer Alex Showalter mentioned he has researched and identified funding for this position from lapsed salaries.

On a motion made by Commissioner Ollison and seconded by Commissioner Heath, the following resolution was unanimously approved.

BE IT RESOLVED, the request from the Sheriff’s Office to add a new temporary Task Force Officer Position through June 30, 2026, is hereby approved. [8a.]

Health Services Consolidation Discussion:

The Board discussed the proposed consolidation of Pamlico Health and Human Services. The consolidation would include Pamlico County Health Department, DSS, Senior Services and Veterans Services. County Manager Mark Brewington mentioned this allows the Board to become the Human & Health Advisory Board. County Manager also mentioned there would need to be a resolution prepared and public hearing with 30-day notice.

On a motion made by Commissioner Bohmert and seconded by Commissioner Brinson , the following resolution was unanimously approved.

BE IT RESOLVED, the request to move forward with the next steps of Pamlico County Health & Human Services Consolidation, is hereby approved.
