







Increase Recycling 1,700 Tons per Year


5,000 Ton's per Year


124 Communities that mandate a specific size Toter

18 Communities are similar in size and scope to Pittsfield

46 Communities offer a second trash cart as an option

62 Communities offer a second recycling cart as an option

Trash & Recycling Toter Size in Other Communities



While not similar in size, three communities offer one 48 Gal toter for trash: Bedford (4,700 Households) Cambridge (44,700 Households) Gardner (8,535 Households)

In Berkshire County Only 2 communities offer a Municipal Curbside Collection



The rest have two options:

- Visit the Transfer Station
- Private Curbside Collection Contractor

\$25 to \$40 per month

Can be as high as \$60 per month!

Pittsfield is at \$22 per month
