<b>What is the Renewable Energy Percentage?</b>	Our Premium Renewable Choice Program Contains 100% Renewable Energy
<b>What is the contract length?</b>	There is no term length associated with your participation in the voluntary Ranch Mirage 100% renewable energy service option. However, failure to pay RMEA electricity charges may result in your return to SCE's bundled service.
<b>How much will Premium Renewable Choice cost?</b>	Premium Renewable Choice's 100% Renewable Energy Service rates are set by the Rancho Mirage City Council during a regularly scheduled public hearing. <b>Will the rate change over time?</b>	RMEA is governed by the Rancho Mirage City Council. Every year, the City Council goes through a rate-setting process based on the projected energy costs for the coming year. This process is held at an annual public hearing during the City Council's regularly scheduled meeting dates. The public is invited to attend and participate.
<b>What are the enrollment options?</b>	RMEA currently offers one opt up program. Premium Renewable Choice gives customers an opportunity to opt up to 100% renewable energy at a competitive price.
<b>What other fees might I be charged?</b>	Southern California Edison (SCE) charges RMEA customers a Power Charge Indifference Adjustment (PCIA) calculated based on the number of kilowatt hours used each month. The PCIA is intended to ensure that SCE's remaining customers do not pay for energy that had been acquired for RMEA's customers prior to their switch. The PCIA vintage for RMEA customers is 2017, and the amount is determined by rate class.
<b>How will I be billed?</b>	Southern California Edison continues to bill for your monthly electricity usage. Your bill will look much as it has in the past.
<b>If I want to terminate service, what is the termination fee?</b>	There is no termination fee should you decide to return to SCE for generation services. You will be subject to SCE's current terms and conditions upon your return.
