LIGHTS CAMERA ACTION!

NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH

is a community based program supported by the Redondo Beach Police Department. It is a partnership between the residents, businesses and the Police Department. Not only are residents our extra eyes and ears to crime prevention, Neighborhood Watch improves the quality of life in local neighborhoods. Staying connected to your neighbors and building a partnership with the Police Department is the key to a successful Neighborhood Watch program. Keeping your private Neighborhood Roster and creating ways to communicate with your group will help to keep everyone informed and safe. Work together to learn about suspicious activity and how to take proper action in reporting and notifying your neighbors. These three steps will help you stay safe.

LIGHTS

- ◆ Turn on your porch lights.
- ◆ Install motion sensor lights around your house and yard.
- ◆ Add solar lighting around your walkways and yard.

CAMERA

- ◆ Add a camera activated door bell camera system.
- ◆ Put cameras around your house and entry points
- ◆ Install a motion sensor camera inside your house.

ACTION

- ◆ See something, say something
- ◆ Report suspicious activity as soon as you see it.
- ◆ Sign Up for South Bay Alerts, text your zip code to 888777 to stay informed.
- ◆ Learn how to keep your family and home safe.
- ◆ Sign Up for the Citizen's Police Academy.
