KALAMAZOO, Mich. – Reinstating weekend hours, Kalamazoo County Animal Services & Enforcement will once again be open Saturdays from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. starting June 10 to offer greater convenience and accessibility for pet owners, animal lovers, and individuals seeking assistance with animal services.

“Last month we added an extra two hours on Wednesdays to facilitate services such as pet licensing, microchipping, and adoption,” said Chad Ensign, Animal Services & Enforcement Director. “Staying open until 7 p.m. once a week has afforded those with busy schedules more time to visit and get the services they need. The community has responded well and we’re happy to continue those efforts on Saturdays going forward.”

KCASE is committed to making animal services more accessible and convenient for the community with the addition of Saturdays and extended hours on Wednesdays. The additional service hours are a result of diligent planning and strategic efforts by the KCASE team to better align services with the needs of the community – an important step toward fulfilling their mission of responsible pet ownership and ensuring the welfares of animals in Kalamazoo County.
