(A) Call to Order

Jose Wheeland, City Official, called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. with a quorum present.

(B) Duties of the Board

Summary: Brief discussion of the duties of the advisory board as passed down by the city of Saginaw city council were discussed.

(C) Approval of Minutes from March Meeting

Minutes were approved unanimously after TNR (Trap/Neuter/Release) change was added to March minutes.

(D) Recommendations for Multi Pet Permit

Under the current city of Saginaw perimeters residents are allowed to house five (5) pets. Three (3) pets of the same species are allowed (i.e three dogs and two cats). Each pet must be

registered with the city for a \$10 registration fee and must provide current proof of rabies vaccinations.

Board members reviewed other surrounding cities policies to discuss guidelines and possible requirements (requiring of spay/neuter of pets over minimum, fee for each additional pet, odor issues, apartments and small family residence. Board discussed the need to identify not only a multi-pet permit, but also consider a foster permit.

Motion made to review policies for foster and multi-pet permit until June meeting. Unanimously approved.

(E) Recommendations for Chair, Vice Chair, and Secretary of Advisory Board

Joseph Stout volunteered for the position of chair and was unanimously approved by the advisory board.

Judy Deller volunteered for the position of vice-chair and was unanimously approved by the advisory board.

Stacy Liebel was nominated by Jose Wheeland for the position of Secretary and was unanimously approved by the advisory board.

(F) Public Comments

Megan Lee, City of Saginaw resident address the advisory board to request that the multipet permit be reconsidered and revised. Ms. Lee is currently a volunteer for a rescue and would like to have the ability to have the flexibility to rescue and foster animals according to need.

(G) Adjournment

Motion was made by Jose Wheeland, with second by Joseph Stout to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried unanimously.
