As the year comes to a close, we would like to reflect on some of the funding successes of 2023.

- SECOG assisted its members with securing more than \$130 million in grants and loans in 2023
- SECOG's members paid \$348,489 in dues in 2023
- For every dollar paid in dues, SECOG's members received a return of \$373.13 in grant and loan funding which amounts to 37,317% return on investment.

Member cities, please focus on city limit boundaries on the map. Your observations and reports of annexations or inaccuracies are vital.

Application Deadline: February 1, 2024

Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)

 CDBG funds are for community projects for a range of community development needs, and typical projects include water and wastewater infrastructure, community centers, workforce training, medical centers, and senior centers.

• Grant amounts have been increased effective October 1st to a maximum of \$2,020,000 per project.

DRINKING WATER SANITARY/STORM SEWER & SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT FACILITIES FUNDING

APPLICATIONS DUE APRIL 1ST



RECREATIONAL TRAILS GRANT PROGRAM (RTP)

• Funds can be used for public motorized and non-motorized trail projects

- Grant awards generally are \$40,000-\$200,000
- 80% Federal grant dollars, 20% local project sponsor, up to approved grant amount
- Grant payment comes as a reimbursement

Upcoming Deadlines

DOT Agri-Business Grants (AG)

- Grants apply to construction of roads meeting minimum program criteria and serving as primary access to an agriculture related business
- Grant amounts are limited to \$600,000
- State provides 80% of the project cost on a reimbursement basis

Applications Due: April 15th



LOCAL INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (LIIP)

- Grants apply to construction or reconstruction of public infrastructure associated with an economic development project
- Open to any political subdivisions in SD, tribal government, or local development corporation
- Board considers the economic impact of the project and the funding available to be utilized by the applicant

Applications due April 30th

Hazard Mitigation Grant Program

• Funding is available for local governments and certain private non-profit organizations for hazard mitigation projects that lessen the impact of future disasters.

• 75% federal match, 10% state match, and a 15% local match is required

Applications are due May 1st






