2024-2027 TIP

The Sioux Falls Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) and the South Dakota Department of Transportation (SDDOT) are in the process of drafting the 2024-2027 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and 2024-2027 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), respectively. The TIP and STIP include prioritized listings of multimodal transportation improvement projects for streets and highways, public transportation, aviation, railroads, bicycles, and pedestrians.

The draft 2024-2027 TIP, which includes transportation improvement projects for the MPO area (Brandon, Crooks, Harrisburg, Hartford, Sioux Falls, Tea, and portions of Lincoln County and Minnehaha County), was presented to the MPO committees at the July 12th and 13th meetings. 



DOT Agri-Business Grants (AG)

- Grants apply to construction of roads meeting minimum program criteria and serving as primary access to an agriculture related business
- Grant amounts limited to \$600,000
- State provides 80% of the project cost on a reimbursement basis

Applications **August 15th**







Community Access Grant Program (CAG)

- State funds to be used for the construction or reconstruction of major streets in towns with a population of 5,000 or less. Major streets include Main Street, the road to the elevator, schools, hospital, etc.
- Grant provides 80% of the construction costs of the project, not including engineering or utility work
- Amounts limited to \$600,000

Application Deadline: August 15, 2023

LOCAL INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (LIIP)

- Grants apply to construction or reconstruction of public infrastructure associated with an economic development project
- Open to any political subdivisions in SD, tribal government, or local development corporation
- Board considers the economic impact of the project and the funding available to and utilized by the applicant

Applications due July 31st

Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)

- CDBG funds are for community projects for a range of community development needs, and typical projects include water and wastewater infrastructure, community centers, workforce training, medical centers, and senior centers.
- Grant amounts have been increased effective October 1st to a maximum of \$2,020,000 on a project.

Sioux Falls Offers Home Repair Programs

The City of Sioux Falls Housing Division is offering home repair and rehabilitation programs. The application can be completed online and aims to help families with low to moderate income levels. The program funding offers the ability to pay for repairs or replacements for items such as plumbing, heating/cooling systems, electrical work, roofs, windows and screens, insulations and winterizations, handicap accessibility, and painting.

The single-family rehab program is for families making less than 80 percent Median Family Income. Rental rehab is for rental owners to maintain their properties in the Sioux Falls city limits. Loan amounts are a \$2,000 minimum and \$30,000 maximum. The mobile home repair program assists residents with low to moderate incomes and offers up to \$5,000 per residence in Sioux Falls. Public Safety down payment assistance offers help to police officers, firefighters, and other public safety employees in Sioux Falls. Applicants can receive up to \$20,000 or 20 percent of the purchase price for a home.

Five-Year County Highway and Bridge Improvement Plan

It is time for counties to undertake the critical task of updating their Five-Year County Highway and Bridge Improvements Plan, commonly known as the Transportation Plan. To maintain eligibility for the State Bridge Improvement Program, the plan must be updated annually. This yearly update must include a comprehensive review of the previous plan's projects and their current status. The updated plan must be submitted to the State Department of Transportation no later than October 15, 2023.

Transportation planning is a collaborative process that aims to engage all users of the system, including the business community, freight operators, and the general public. This involvement is fostered through an active and inclusive public participation process conducted by the County. The planning process also encourages effective communication among local governments, such as townships, to collectively address transportation needs and coordinate improvement efforts.

The Bridge Improvement Grant (BIG) program was established during the 2015 legislative session through Senate Bill 1 (SB1). SB1 allocated \$7 million annually for the BIG program. Funding for this program is derived from license plate fees and non-commercial vehicle fees. Additionally, the State Department of Transportation will allocate \$8 million per year from state gas tax funds, resulting in a total of \$15 million available for BIG grants.


