The meeting was called to order via video conference by Chair Cory Diedrich at 3:01 p.m. The roll was called, and a quorum was present.

- 1. Public Input on Non-Agenda Items:** Amy Bruner shared a parent's concern about children crossing Veterans Parkway/Highway 11 at 41st Street due to the speed and many lanes to cross to get to the new Ben Reifel Middle School, which is opening fall of 2021. As a short-term solution for the 2021-2022 school year, the Sioux Falls School District will provide a shuttle bus for these children to be picked up Manifold Avenue (Harmodon Park) and brought to the middle school entrance. In addition, the City of Sioux Falls will install speed advisory signs on Veterans Parkway that will flash during school walk times. City of Sioux Falls and School District will conduct a 1-year traffic study around the intersection of Veterans Parkway and 41st Street. Long-term solutions will be considered after the study is completed.
