1. **Public Input on Non-Agenda Items:** There was no public input.
2. **Approval of the August 10, 2022 Minutes:** Mark Hoffman made a motion to approve the August 10, 2022, minutes and was seconded by Dave Jackson. A voice vote was called, and the motion carried unanimously.
3. **Coordinated Public Transit-Human Services Transportation Plan Annual Progress Report:** Jim Feeney and Sam Trebilcock presented the Annual Progress Report for the Coordinated Public Transit – Human Services Transportation Plan. Chuck Parsons made a motion to recommend approval of the Coordinated Public Transit – Human Services Transportation Plan Annual Progress Report and was seconded by Gayleen Riedemann. A voice vote was called, and the motion carried unanimously.
4. **Rice Street/Holly Boulevard Corridor Study Public Participation Plan:** Shannon Ausen presented the Rice Street/Holly Boulevard Corridor Study Public Participation Plan. Gayleen Riedemann made a motion to recommend approval of the Public Participation Plan and was seconded by Chuck Parsons. A voice vote was called, and the motion carried unanimously.
5. **Sioux Falls TA Application Letter of Support:** Shannon Ausen presented the City of Sioux Falls' Transportation Alternatives (TA) grant application to construct a 5,200-foot-long shared use path connecting a crossing underneath 26<sup>th</sup> Street to the Veteran's Parkway side path. Dave Jackson made a motion to recommend approval of a letter of support for the Sioux Falls TA grant application and was seconded by Jesse Fonkert. A voice vote was called, and the motion carried unanimously.
6. **Letter of Support for SDDOT's Opposition to Greenhouse Gas Performance Measure Rulemaking:** Shannon Ausen presented the letter supporting SDDOT's opposition to the proposed National Performance Management Measures; Assessing Performance of the National Highway System, Greenhouse Gas Emissions Measure. Dave Jackson made a motion to recommend approval of the letter of support and was seconded by Mark Hoffman. A voice vote was called, and the motion carried unanimously.
7. **I-29/Exit 86 (Crooks/Renner) Interchange Modification Justification Report (IMJR) Study:** Al Murra, SEH Inc., presented an update on the Interstate 29/Exit 86 (Crooks/Renner) IMJR study. This was for informational purposes only.
