APPROVAL OF MINUTES

OLD BUSINESS

1. John Murphy—Waldon Pool update
 - A. EMC as not received a revised plan to review.
 - B. M. Singer pointed out parking lot access problem.
 - C. J. Foster inquired if building will be sprinklered.
 - D. General discussion on illumination for pool.
2. John Murphy—294 Woods Drive
 - A. D. McDonald pointed out not precluding road access to Woods.
 - B. J. Huff discussed that Woods is a mecca for traffic violation issues.
 - C. Roadway solution needed.
 - i. J. Murphy suggested camera for enforcement of truck traffic; it would ease policing with a direct feed to police department.
 - ii. M. Ott stated that PennDOT does not use cameras for enforcement.
 - iii. G. Hostetler pointed out that truck traffic will significantly increase on Trindle Run bridge...need a Bridge Weight sign.
 - iv. D. McDonald noted a high volume of speeding cars and school traffic increasing.



- v. M. Ott suggested painting “NO TRUCKS” on the road surface, as it has worked in Upper Allen Twp.
 - vi. J. Huff also suggested “NO TRUCKS” be painted on road surface on Woods Drive at the intersection at Hogestown Road
 - D. J. Murphy noted that building was not at flood plain
 - E. J. Foster to coordinate existing fire hydrants. Flow to be provided to Jason by fire department.
 - F. D. Hostetler stated that residential development across from Woods needs to be publicly announced.
 - G. G. Hostetler inquired whether developer will run water back to Woods.
 - H. J. Murphy to provide Fayette Twp. information to J. Huff.
3. ESF Annex Comments
- A. EMC still working through ESF Annexes. As they become complete, they will be released to the various agencies.
 - B. D. McDonald asked that the ESFs be expandable and fluid.

NEW BUSINESS

- 1. 90 West Main Street, New Kingstown—Amended Final LD
 - a. J. Foster to email to J. Murphey the hydrant information
 - b. Glen pointed out that there is a sprinkler located across the street, within 600 feet.
- 2. PPL—West Shore Service Subdivision
 - a. J. Foster stated at this time they are not requiring access road
- 3. 76 Linda Drive—Minor Subdivision
 - a. J. Foster noted access drives to properties
 - b. General conversation on stormwater

GOOD OF THE AGENCY

- 1. J. Foster stated:
 - a. that Kimberly Largent-Christopher started August 17, 2015; she will be attending future meetings and will take minutes.
 - b. that based on the water flow results received from PA American Water regarding 192 Kost Road, it appears a fire tank and pump house will be required. A meeting will be held with representatives on August 19, 2015, to go over building code requirements, including fire flows.
 - c. that the township Board of Supervisors approved changing the name of Emergency Management Council to “Emergency Management Agency,” effective 8/12/2015.
- 2. D. Hoffman pointed out that emergency service will soon get NARCAN™
- 3. Supervisor Kertes said a new chief has been selected and will be named on August 31, 2015.
- 4. D. McDonald stated the Firehouse open house is tentatively slated for October 11, 2015.
- 5. J. Foster stated the pipeline is coming through the area and will be south of turnpike.
