“If any person knowingly perform the ceremony of marriage without lawful license, or officiate in celebrating the rites of marriage without being authorized by law to do so, he shall be confined in jail not exceeding one year, and fined not exceeding \$500.”

I request the Court to grant me the authority to perform marriages in the Commonwealth of Virginia pursuant to §20-25 of the Code of Virginia, and I understand that if such authority is granted, before performing any marriages, I will first be required to appear before the Clerk and post bond, and I further acknowledge that such authority may be rescinded at any time.
