To be eligible for the exemption for the principal residence of a veteran, or his or her surviving spouse, the veteran must have a 100% service-connected, permanent and total disability. This ruling is extended to the surviving spouse of an eligible veteran so long as the death of the veteran occurs on or after January 1, 2011 and the surviving spouse does not remarry and said spouse continues to occupy the real property as his /her place of residence.

- 1) A certification of this disability from the Department of Veterans Affairs must be provided to the Smyth County Commissioner of the Revenue before this exemption can be granted.
