

Council Meeting Actions

The Town Council has taken the following actions:

- Approval of a three-year contract agreement with Lindsay + Associates, LLC to provide independent auditing services for fiscal years 2021, 2022, and 2023 in the amounts of \$11,200, \$11,360, and \$11,740, respectively, as recommended by the Town Audit Committee.
- Appointment of **Yogesh Rajkotia** (Deal) to the Environment Committee, with a term expiration of December 31, 2021, as nominated by Mayor Slavin.

- Adopted Ordinance No. 4-12-2, an Ordinance to amend the Code of Ordinances to allow administrative approval for the replacement of air-conditioning units and heat/cool pumps.
- Approval of a shred event, battery collection, and light bulb exchange at the Town Hall parking lot on Saturday, September 18, as requested by Phyllis Wiesenfelder (Cumberland), and recommended by the Environment Committee.
- Approved of a Town-sanctioned pickleball demonstration at the basketball court at Capello Park, at a cost not to exceed \$500.
- Approved of a Town forum on THRIVE Montgomery 2050, at a date to-be-determined in late August or early September.
- Approved of a contract addendum with American Pool to keep the Town Pool open through October 31, 2021, as recommended by the Town Pool Committee.
