

Council Meeting Actions

The following actions were taken by the Somerset Town Council at its monthly meeting, held October 4, 2021.

- Approved a one-month extension through November 2021 for the continued use of Zoom as a virtual Town Meeting setting (currently set to expire October 31, 2021).
- Re-Introduced Ordinance No. 6-21-1, an ordinance to amend the Code of Ordinances to require a stormwater drainage plan for new construction projects; to add stormwater drainage plan requirements; to add to the statement of intents and purposes; to add definitions; to require a pre-permit informational meeting; and to apply the existing variance procedures to the new stormwater drainage plan requirements.
- Approved a Proclamation declaring November Municipal Government Works Month.
- Approved the Mayor's nomination of **Fayez Choudhury** (Dorset) to serve on the Equity & Inclusion Committee, to fill the term vacated by **Janet Leissner** (Essex).
- Approved a three-month extension to the terms of the Stormwater Study Committee members through January 5, 2022 (currently set to expire October 5, 2021).
- Updated authorized signers on Town of Somerset Checking Account to include current Council members.
- Approved Food Trucks and Band Entertainment at the Somerset Town Pool on the weekends of October 15, 2021, and October 29, 2021.
- Introduced Ordinance 8-21-1, an ordinance to amend the Code of Ordinances to require a permit for a food truck operating within a Town park.
- Introduced a Resolution establishing a Revenue Committee.
- Introduced Ordinance No. 10-21-4, an ordinance to amend the Code of Ordinances to prohibit the use of gas-powered blowers on or after September 1, 2022, as recommended by the Town Environment Committee.
- Approved entering into an agreement with Open Water Aquatics (OWA) to host private swim lessons at the Somerset Pool through the month of October from 4:30 – 5:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday, as recommended by the Town Pool Committee.
