

# Council Meeting Actions

The following actions were taken by the Somerset Town Council at its monthly meeting, held April 4, 2022:

## Council Actions:

- Approved Road closures on the Somerset 5K race route from 8:30 – 10:00 am on Sunday, May 1, as requested by the Somerset Elementary School PTA, to accommodate the Somerset Elementary School PTA Somerset 2K Race fundraising event on Sunday, May 1. The race will follow the below track:
  - Warwick → Falstone → Uppingham → Greystone → Falstone → Surrey → Dorset → Surrey → Cumberland → Warwick → Dorset → Falstone → Surrey → Dorset → Kenwood → Dorset;
- Approved the renewal of the trash, recycling, and yard waste contract with Goode Companies, Inc. for Option Year June 2022 – May 2023 at an annual cost of \$145,359.
- Approved the following bulk trash and donation pickup schedule for May, 2022:
  - Saturday, May 14: Donation Nation & A Wider Circle donation pickups
  - Sunday, May 15: Donation Nation additional pickups
  - Monday, May 16: Bulk Trash pickup.
- Approved a HVAC replacement permit application submitted by **Robert and Nancy Soreng**, for the installation of a new HVAC unit at the location of the existing failed unit, at the property located at 5506 Uppingham Street
- Approved a HVAC replacement permit application submitted by **Ruth Albert** for the installation of a new HVAC unit at the location of existing failed unit, at the property located at 4701 Falstone Avenue
- Approved a building permit application submitted by **Kara Petteway** and **Joseph Wheatley**, for the construction of a backyard shed at the property located at 4507 Dorset Avenue
- Approved a building permit application submitted by **Chris Conlan** of C. M. Conlan Contractors & Builders Inc., for the demolition and construction of a new single-family home at the property located at 5506 Trent Street, pending the applicant obtaining and submitting a Montgomery County permit for the identical work.
- Approved a Resolution establishing the 2022 Somerset Dolphins Team Rules, Calendar, and Budget, as recommended by the Town Swim Team Committee
- Introduced an ordinance adopting the Town of Somerset Fiscal Year 2023 Budget and Tax Rates, as submitted by Mayor Slavin per the Somerset Charter Section 83-41.
- Introduced a Charter Amendment to lower the eligible voting age from 18 to 16 for municipal elections in the Town of Somerset.
- Approved a contract with Revize LLC of Troy, MI, for the design and hosting of a new Town website, at a cost not to exceed \$18,000, as recommend by the Town Communications Committee.
