

Council Meeting Actions

The following actions were taken:

- Approval of December 4, 2023 Minutes
- Approval of the following Committee Chair appointments:
 - **Ann Bolten** (Cumberland) – Budget
 - **Leslie Caplan** (Essex) – Communications
 - **Barton Rubenstein** (Dorset) – Environment
 - **Josh Rosenthal** (River) - Parks and Natural Resources
 - **Matt Zaft** (Dorset) – Pool

 - **Carrie Wofford** (Essex) – Tennis
- Approval of a permit application, submitted by **Daniel Bremer-Wirtig** and **Rebecca Lamadrid**, to add a rear deck and wall at the property located at 5613 Warwick Place (NOTE: The applicants are planning to seek an amendment for a replacement driveway at a future time, though a variance may be required. The driveway was not under consideration by the Council at this meeting.)
- Introduction of a Resolution Condemning Antisemitism*
- Introduction of a Resolution establishing the 2024 Pool Rules^
- Adoption of a Resolution establishing Reasonable Accommodation procedures
- Adoption of a Resolution in support of the Maryland Municipal League’s legislative priority advocating for a State bill that would allow municipalities to issue citations for red light cameras; and advocating for municipalities to use stop sign cameras, as recommended by the Traffic Committee
- Adoption of an Ordinance to amend the Code of Ordinances to clarify that above-grade stormwater collection and drainage devices, including micro-bio-retention boxes, are subject to building regulations
