A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOMERTON, ARIZONA AMENDING FEE SCHEDULES FOR CITY SERVICES PROVIDED BY CITY CLERK, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, FIRE, POLICE AND PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENTS, AND THE MUNICIPAL COURT, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF JULY 1, 2026.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that from time to time, fees and charges will be reviewed periodically to determine a reasonable recovery of costs incurred to provide City services; and,

WHEREAS, as adopted by Ordinance No. 2013-006, Article 2-5-10 of the City Code of the City of Somerton requires that when a charge is assessed for provision of a service, the amount of the assessment shall be set in the form of resolution and adopted by the Council;

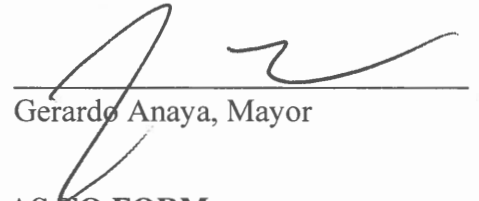
WHEREAS a Notice of the City's intent to increase municipal fees was published on the City's website on February 18, 2026, and a Public Hearing held on June 2, 2026;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of City of Somerton of Yuma County, Arizona as follows:

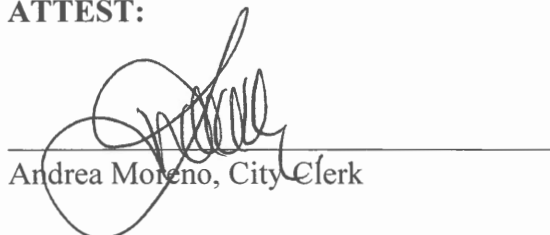
Section 1: That the fee schedule as set forth in Schedule "1" attached hereto and hereby incorporated by reference in its entirety, be adopted as of the 1st day of July 2026.

Section 2: It is understood and agreed that if any part, term or provision of this Resolution is held to be illegal or in conflict with any law of the State of Arizona, the validity of the remaining portions or provisions shall not be affected and shall be enforced as if the Resolution did not contain the particular part, term or provision held to be invalid.
