

ORDER OF PROBATION

The defendant, _____, having been convicted of the offense of _____ on the _____ day of _____, 20____, is sentenced to serve _____ with _____ suspended during his/her good behavior and placed on probation for a period of _____, under the following terms and conditions:

1. You shall not violate any laws or ordinances.
2. It is your responsibility to report to your Probation Officer at least once a month or as directed by such officer. You shall permit a Probation Officer to visit you at home or any place designated by your officer. You shall submit to search of your person, property, or residence upon reasonable suspicion.
3. You shall neither possess nor associate with people who are in possession of illegal drugs or knowingly be where illegal drugs are present. You shall permit the Probation Department to conduct any and all tests, including urinalysis, at any time or place to determine if you have consumed illegal drugs. You shall pay for the costs of these tests as an additional probation user's fee.
4. You shall answer truthfully all questions asked by your Probation Officer.
5. You shall notify the Probation Department within two days of a change of address, employment, if you are detained or questioned by a police officer, or charged with a new criminal offense.
6. You shall associate only with law-abiding persons and shall maintain reasonable hours.
7. You shall waive any privilege of confidentiality concerning the release of medical, mental health, law enforcement, and educational records.
8. You shall find and maintain full time employment. You shall not be terminated or fired from your employment for any cause of poor work performance, reliability, or lack of cooperation. You shall not voluntarily terminate any employment without approval of your Probation Officer.
9. You shall follow all orders given to you by the Court or reasonable rules imposed by your Probation Officer. You shall participate in any programming deemed necessary by your Probation Officer.
10. You shall remain within the State of Indiana unless you are granted permission to leave by the Court and/or Interstate Compact as set out in special condition #13.

ALL FINES, COSTS, RESTITUTION AND PROBATION USER'S FEE ARE DUE WITHIN 6 MONTHS OR AS ORDERED BY THE COURT, AND MUST BE PAID BY CASH, OR MONEY ORDER TO: Steuben County Clerk, 55 Public Square, Angola, IN 46703. Fees may be paid in full or partial payments.

THE STEUBEN COUNTY CLERK MAY ASSESS A LATE FEE OF \$25.00 IF ALL FEES ARE NOT PAID BY THE DATE ORDERED BY THE COURT.

THE FOLLOWING CHECKED TERMS ARE SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF YOUR PROBATION

12. _____ You shall not own, possess, or have under your control a firearm, destructive device, or dangerous weapon without permission from your Probation Officer or the Court.
13. _____ You may return to your State of Residence. Any time that you are outside the jurisdiction of the Court, for any reason, you will agree to waive extradition to the State of Indiana and return voluntarily to the jurisdiction of this Court.
14. _____ You shall have your driver's license suspended for _____
15. _____ Your driver's license shall be a probationary driver's license for _____

16. ___ You shall complete _____ hours of community service within _____ months and provide written verification of completion to Steuben County Community Corrections. You shall be required to pay a community service fee of \$125.00. Failure to report for scheduled community service work is a violation of probation and a motion to revoke probation will be filed.
17. ___ You shall not possess or consume alcoholic beverages and you shall not go into any place which serves alcoholic beverages and in which minors are not allowed.
18. ___ You shall work diligently at obtaining your GED and you shall faithfully attend GED classes as directed by your Probation Officer. You shall take the GED examination until such time as you have obtained your GED.
19. ___ You shall complete _____ days of Community Corrections/Work Release. You shall follow all rules and pay all costs of said program. ___ Direct Placement ___ Not Direct Placement.
20. ___ You shall complete _____ weekends in Jail; _____ days in Jail.
21. ___ You will execute a written reimbursement plan to compensate Steuben County for all or part of the costs incurred by the County during the time of your incarceration in Steuben County, Indiana.
22. ___ Within five days of today's date you shall:
 - ___ Schedule an appointment to complete an alcohol/substance abuse evaluation.
 - ___ Schedule an appointment to complete a psychological/psychiatric evaluation;
 - ___ Schedule an appointment to begin sexual offenders' and/or non-violence counseling at _____, phone _____

You shall immediately attend any and all treatment or counseling sessions which are recommended by the above evaluation(s). You shall pay for each session, provide written verification that you have attended all sessions required of you, and provide a written verification of successful completion of any and all such treatment within six months of today's date. Failure to attend a scheduled counseling session without approval of your counselor will constitute a violation of probation. You shall waive confidentiality concerning the evaluations or treatment.

OTHER: _____

If the Court has reason to believe that you have violated any of the terms of your probation, within 45 days after the State receives notification of a violation and no later than one year from the date of the termination of your probation, it may issue a summons for your appearance or a warrant for your arrest. If the Court finds that you have violated any of the terms of probation, it may continue you on the existing conditions, modify the conditions, or order imposition of the sentence that was suspended and commit you to the Department of Corrections or Steuben County Jail.
