RESOLUTION 2023-2

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENT AND AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF MUNICIPALLY OWNED PERSONAL PROPERTY, INCLUDING MOTOR VEHICLES, ROAD MACHINERY, EQUIPMENT, TOOLS OR SUPPLIES, WHICH ARE NOT NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE, OR ARE OBSOLETE OR UNFIT FOR THE USE FOR WHICH THEY WERE ACQUIRED, DURING THE CALENDAR YEAR 2023 BY INTERNET AUCTION, PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE, SEC. 721.15(D)

Whereas, Ohio Revised Code, Sec. 721.15 authorizes a municipality to dispose of unneeded, obsolete, or unfit personal property through the use of an internet auction, and

Whereas, Ohio Revised Code, Sec. 721.15(D) requires the legislative authority of a municipality to adopt, during every calendar year, a resolution expressing its intent to sell personal property by internet auction, of which the municipality may conduct itself or contract with another to conduct such auction, and

Whereas, GovDeals, Inc. at govdeals.com, Municibid.Com LLC, at municipbid.com, and Don R. Wallick Auction, Inc. at DonRWallickAuction.com are appropriate entities to use for such internet auctions,

Now Therefore, Village Council Resolves as follows:

1. During the calendar year 2023, municipally owned personal property which is not needed for public use, or which is obsolete or unfit for the use for which it was acquired, as determined pursuant to the procedure set forth in Ohio Revised Code, Sec. 721.15(D) may be sold at internet auction.
2. Any auction shall be conducted under the authority and direction of the Village Administrator or his designee.
3. Such internet auction sales may be conducted by contract with GovDeals, Inc. or Municibid.Com, LLC internet auction services, pursuant to the rules and regulations promulgated and in effect for that sales organization, to be on file with the Village Fiscal Officer, and as amended from time to time.
4. In connection with each such contemplated internet auction sale, bidding shall remain open for not less than ten (10) days, including Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays.

5. In connection with each such contemplated internet auction sale, the terms of payment shall be made with: cashiers check, certified check, money order, company check (with bank letter guaranteeing payment), or cash, for payment in full on or before the date of pick-up by the successful bidder. Further, the successful bidder shall be solely responsible for all acts and expenses associated with the pick-up of such item(s) so purchased. The successful bidder may be subject to payment of Ohio or other sales and/or use taxes. The Village of Strasburg will not be responsible for collection of taxes. The successful bidder is responsible for contacting the appropriate tax office, completing any forms, and paying any taxes that may be imposed.

6. The Village Fiscal Officer shall publish a summary notice of this resolution twice in a newspaper of general circulation, and to post this notice throughout calendar year 2023 in a conspicuous place in Village Hall, and on the Village's website in accordance with the publication requirements of Ohio Revised Code, Sec. 721.15(D).


7. This resolution is an *emergency*, in that internet auctions may be required on very short notice, and the Village is best served by this Resolution taking immediate effect upon passage by Village Council; thus the three reading requirement is waived.
