PUT RECYCLING CURBSIDE BY 6AM

Put paper, flattened cardboard, empty, clean bottles & cans all into your blue cart together!

RECYCLE RIGHT!
Only recycle items listed. Carts with non-acceptable items, trash, or plastic bags will be rejected.

PROTECT YOUR PROPERTY

Cart Placement Instructions

3-5 Feet Clearance on All Sides of Recycling Cart



Place cart at curb with front of cart facing street.
OTC is not responsible for property damage due to improper cart placement. Improperly placed carts may not be serviced.

NEEDLES ARE DANGEROUS!

We are finding medical needles on recycling sort lines – PLEASE PROTECT OUR WORKERS – KEEP NEEDLES OUT OF RECYCLING

Safe Syringe Disposal Program –

Lourdes Medical Center (Willingboro) 609-835-2900, Virtua Hospital (Mt. Holly) 609-267-0700, and Virtua (Marlton) 856-355-6000 will provide syringe disposal containers for a one-time fee of \$10.

Otherwise –

- Put needles in sturdy plastic container
- Put a warning label on container “Used Syringes”
- Seal bottle tightly with cap and duct tape
- Put in household trash – **DO NOT RECYCLE**



RECYCLE:

THESE ITEMS INSIDE YOUR BLUE CART

MAKE SURE METAL BAR FACES THE STREET

Paper and Flattened Cardboard

Newspaper, junk mail, magazines, catalogs, paperbacks, brown bags, gray paperboard (cereal & tissue boxes), school and office paper.



Plastic Bottles and Food Containers

Including berry boxes and yogurt cups.



Glass Bottles and Jars

Labels are okay!



Metal Cans

Cans ONLY. Other metal items jam and damage sorting equipment. Attached metal lids are okay.



Cartons



PUT RECYCLING CURBSIDE BY 6 A.M.

NO PLASTIC BAGS!

They get tangled in sorting screens. Recycle at grocery stores.



DO NOT RECYCLE:

NO plastic wrap or newspaper sleeves.



NO tanglers – hoses, cords or wire hangers.



NO plastic plant pots, pill bottles or flat plastic (like trays and lids).



NO aluminum foil or trays.



NO hardback books, food soiled or frozen food boxes.



NO bulbs, glassware or window glass.



NO motor oil, paint, pesticide containers or propane tanks.



NO plastic with a 3, 4, 6, or 7 symbol (like styrofoam).



NO loose caps or any hot or cold drinking cups/straws.



NO batteries.



RECYCLING TIPS

- Flatten boxes.
- Remove and throw away Styrofoam and plastic wrap.
- Empty and rinse all containers.
- Do NOT flatten aluminum cans.
- No need to remove any labels.
- Your municipal recycling dropoff is available for overflow.



NO SHREDDED PAPER (EVEN IF BAGGED OR BOXED)

Paper shreds are too small to sort; it just jams equipment and ultimately ends up in the trash.

You can bring it to County Shredder Days or to a special dropoff at the County Resource Recovery Complex.
