Traffic Safety Advisory Committee
Meeting Minutes
November 17, 2021

The Traffic Safety Advisory Committee (TSAC) held a public meeting on Wednesday, September 15, 2021 in person at the Barre Town Municipal building. Committee members present were Jeff Blow (via Teams), Dave Freeman (via Teams), and Bret Meyer (via Teams). Also present was Town Engineer Josh Martineau and Vinny Calcangi (via Teams).

Bret Myer called the meeting to order at 7:10 p.m.

Jeff Blow made a motion, seconded by Dave Freeman, to approve the meeting agenda as presented. The motion was approved unanimously.

On a motion by Jeff Blow, seconded by Dave Freeman, the TSAC voted unanimously to approve the September 15, 2021 meeting minutes as presented.

There was no guest for non-agenda items.

5. Consider 4-Way Stop Beckley Hill Road – Vinny Calcagni, of 372 Beckley Hill Road, is requesting that the intersection of Beckley Hill and School Road be a 4-way stop. After questions and answers with Mr. Calcagni, to understand the request, Jeff made the motion to gather traffic and ticket data from the police department, and conduct a speed study next year. Motion was seconded by Dave, motion passed unanimously.

6. Speed Study on Farwell St – Bill John, of 423 Farwell Street. Has expressed his concerns with speeding and traffic at the end of Farwell Street between his house and the East Montpelier town line. After some discussion, Dave made the motion to conduct a speed study in the area of Bill's house next year. Jeff seconded the motion, and the motion was passed unanimously.

7. Consider "No Outlet" Sign on Al Monty Lane – Margret McKeown, of 13 Al Monty Lane, is requesting a "No Outlet" sign be placed at the beginning of Al Monty Lane. A brief discussion was held, and Dave made the motion to install the "No Outlet" sign at the beginning of Al Monty Lane. Jeff seconded the motion, the motion unanimously passed.

8. Other Business – Dave talked about the overweight ordinance from Shelburne, and the committee would like to work towards an ordinance for the Town. The next meeting will be used to work on the ordinance.

Next Meeting – The committee chose to skip the December meeting and meet in January.

At 7:38 p.m. on a motion by Dave Freeman, seconded by Jeff Blow, TSAC voted unanimously to adjourn.
