Traffic Safety Advisory Committee
Meeting Minutes
March 16, 2022

The Traffic Safety Advisory Committee (TSAC) held a public meeting on Wednesday, March 16, 2022 in person at the Barre Town Municipal building. Committee members present were Jeff Blow, Bret Meyer, Dave Freeman, and Shaun Corbett (via Teams). Also present was Town Engineer Josh Martineau.

Shaun Corbett called the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m.

Jeff Blow made a motion, seconded by Bret Meyer, to approve the meeting agenda as presented. The motion was approved unanimously.

On a motion by Dave Freeman, seconded by Bret Meyer, the TSAC voted unanimously to approve the January 19, 2022 meeting minutes as presented.

There was no guest for non-agenda items.

5. Review Overweight Truck Ordinance – TSAC reviewed the overweight truck ordinance that the Police Department created. There was a brief discussion and the committee concluded they would like to present the ordinance to the Selectboard on April 5th.

6. Speed Studies – TSAC discussed locations for the Central Vermont Regional Planning Commission (CVRPC) to conduct speed studies around town. The following roads were chosen for the studies:

- Windywood Road
- Hill Street
- Camp Street
- Cassie Street
- Beckley Hill Road
- Farwell Street
- Brook Street
- Upper Prospect Street
- Middle Road

The committee also discussed a few possible locations for new radar signs to be placed.

7. Other Business – There was a motion by Jeff to allow the Town Engineer to sign approved meeting minutes when there is a virtual meeting and seconded by Bret. The Motion passed unanimously.

There was also discussion about more ways to keep trucks off Middle Road. TSAC would like to investigate a grant to purchase a message board.
