Traffic Safety Advisory Committee
Meeting Minutes
September 21, 2022

The Traffic Safety Advisory Committee (TSAC) held a public meeting on Wednesday, September 21, 2022 in person at the Barre Town Municipal building. Committee members present were Bret Meyer, Dave Freeman, Vinny Calcagni, Shaun Corbett, and Tony Amaral. Also present was Town Engineer Josh Martineau.

Shaun Corbett called the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m.

Bret Meyer made a motion, seconded by Tony Amaral, to approve the meeting agenda as presented. The motion was approved unanimously.

On a motion by Tony Amaral, seconded by Bret Meyer, the TSAC voted unanimously to approve the July 20, 2022 meeting minutes as presented.

There was no guest for non-agenda items.

5. Bus Stops – TSAC reviewed the list of bus stop given to them from Barre Town Elementary School. The school requested two new locations, Richardson Road, by Rudd Farm, and Camire Hill Road, by House number 19. The school also would like to remove the Gregoire Street sign since there is no longer a student on the street. Motion by Bret Meyer to approve the two new locations and remove the sign no longer in use. Second by Dave Freeman, motion passed unanimously.

6. Richardson Road Crosswalk - TSAC reviewed the request to install a crosswalk on Richardson Road near Vellie Avenue and Rudd Farm Drive. TSAC reviewed the VTrans guidance for crosswalks and determined it did not meet the criteria to install a crosswalk.

7. Other Business – Town Engineer, Josh Martineau, updated TSAC about the status of the last speed study and upcoming line striping.
