

Below are a list of leads for who the various people are that are buried at Maplewood Cemetery in Barre Town. Most of the information comes from genealogy websites, some have a subscription required, and others do not. Occasionally, information is taken from other sources such as gazetteers or family genealogy books, those sources have separate footnotes. Anyone wanting further information about the residents of Maplewood are encouraged to do their own research. In general, a town listed without a related state refers to a town in Vermont. Other locations outside of Vermont have their states identified.

This list addresses the historical rather than the more modern sections of Maplewood. Many of those listed are original or very early settlers of Wildersburgh, now Barre. Everyone at the cemetery has a story that could be told, they all have important dates associated with life's events. As our cemeteries age and monuments begin to disappear, the list below is a minor attempt to preserve the names and dates of some of those related to Maplewood.

The burial cards listed below are not the original cards, but are from a set made up in the 1930s. Workers transcribed other records onto the cards, they generally carry a date of December 1919 and have been certified by _____, clerk. The cards have Maplewood as the cemetery name, undoubtedly to identify the cemetery as it has become known as. Earlier in the history of Maplewood, records referred to the burial ground as the Farwell Cemetery.

As the data presented comes from another century, some of the medical terms used in the cards is archaic as well. With that in mind, here is a brief glossary:

Apoplexy, a term usually associated with a stroke

Bright's disease, chronic inflammation of the kidneys

Consumption, tuberculosis, called consumption as sufferers experience drastic weight loss

Diphtheria, bacterial infection that can cause swallowing and breathing problems

Dropsy, accumulation of excess fluid in the body tissues, usually under the skin

Oliver, d Aug 31, 1808, age 4y,8m,3d, Killed by the fall of a tree, son of William and Bashaby

- Card: birth: Oliver Gouldsbury, born 1803, Dec 28, to Bashua and Wm. Gouldsbury, in Barre.

- Card: burial: Goldsbary, Oliver, age 4-8-3, son of William and Bathsheba, died Aug 31, 1808 in Barre, buried Maplewood Cemetery, killed by fall of a tree.

William, d May 12, 1815, age 54y, Revolutionary War

William Gouldsbury married Bathsheba Walker 30 Jan 1795 in Brookfield, MA.
