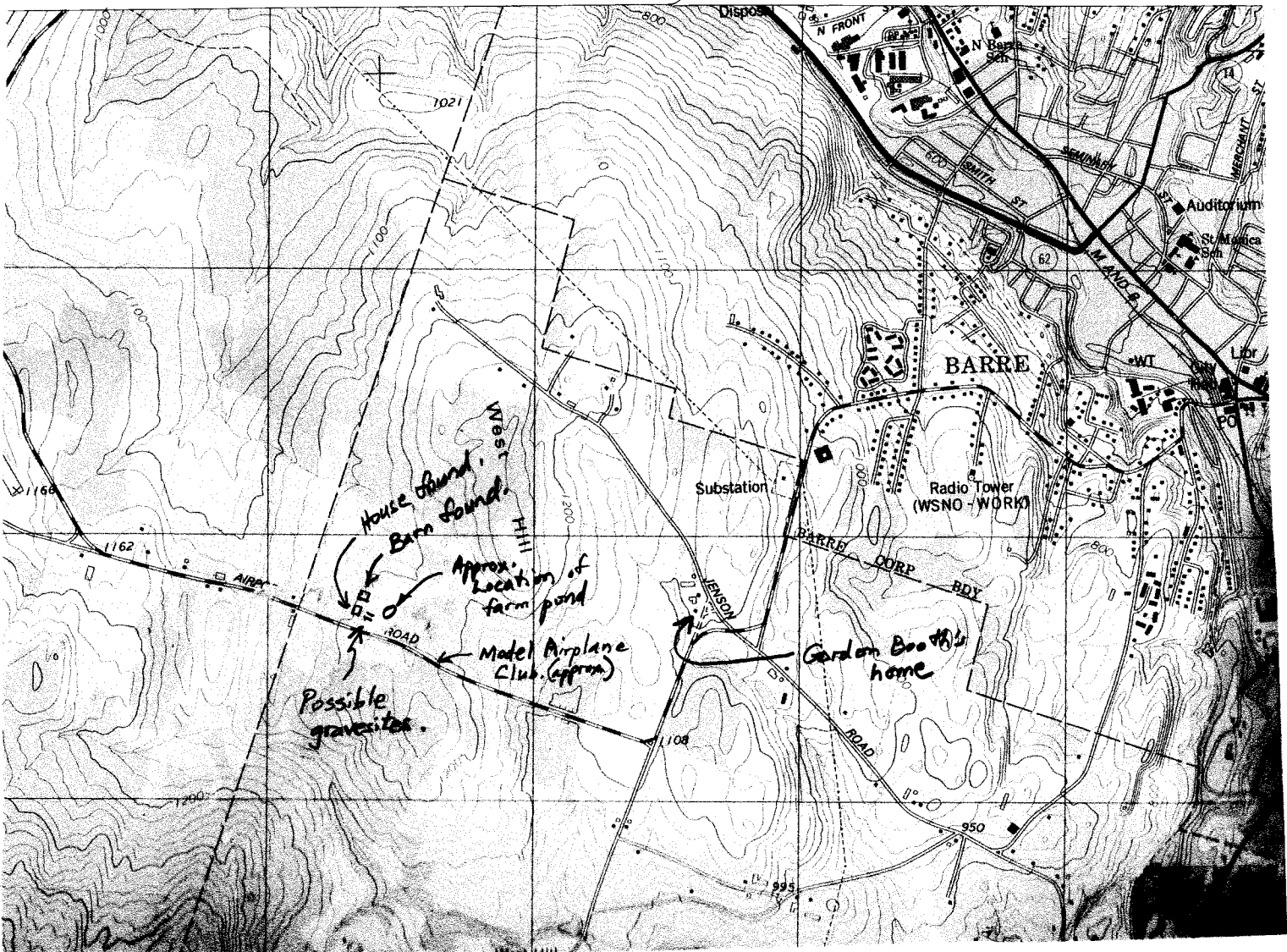


# Oldest Tombstone found in Barre Town, Vermont

Slate stone in very good condition; viewed by lamp light in the cellar of Gordon Booth's home on Jensen Road in Barre Town, on the 17<sup>th</sup> of September, 2004. He believes the stone belongs to a grave located on land he owns on Airport Road, just west of where the model airplane club is located, and near a farm pond, but close to the road (between farm pond and house and barn cellar holes – see map below).
