The duly warned Barre Town Middle and Elementary School District Annual Meeting, Central Vermont Career Center Annual Meeting, and Presidential Primary elections by Australian ballot was held on Tuesday, March 5, 2024 at Barre Town Middle and Elementary School Gymnasium, 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m. The Board of Civil Authority met on February 7, 2024 to update the checklist.

POSTING CERTIFICATION:

All advertising, postings, and meetings were administered in accordance with VSA Title 17 and the Town of Barre Charter Sections 3a and 6c. Advertising was through the Times Argus Newspaper and posting locations included: Hannaford's Market, Graniteville General Store, Lawson's Store, The Barre Municipal Building, and the Town website.

Barre Unified Union School District Annual Election and Presidential Primary Election:

The Barre Unified Union School District ballots were counted using the ImageCast Precinct 2 tabulator #2. The Presidential Primary ballots were counted using the ImageCast Precinct 2 tabulator #1.

The total number of voters on the checklist after the additions is 6300 There were 18 same day voter registrations (Brady Aldrich, Jennifer Beach-McKelvey, Nolan Benoit, Carol Blake, Ricky Boutin, Rhonda Cook, Rhea Costantino, Cecile Gendron, Glenn Hobbs, Monica Hobbs, Richard Lafond, John Malnati, Patrick Miner, Daniel Pudvah, Taylor Sgroi, Claire Simonetti, Nikolas Stein, Robert Stratton).

A total of 2009 ballots were casted (32% turnout) with 776 of those being early ballots. There were 0 defective ballots.

Central Vermont Career Center Election:

On Election Day the Barre Town ballots were fed through the ImageCast Precinct 2 tabulator #3. Clerk Lunt confirms that a total of 2052 ballots were received in Barre Town. Write-in votes were totaled at the polls. Beginning, Thursday, March 8, 2024, CVCCSD Clerk Tina Lunt oversaw the co-mingling of the Central Vermont Career Center Election. The remaining towns within the CVCCSD brought their ballots to the Barre Auditorium for commingling. A total of 14,115 ballot were casted.
