

TOWN OF BARRE STATEWIDE PRIMARY ELECTION

August 26, 2014

The duly warned Statewide Primary Elections were on Tuesday, August 26, 2014 at the Barre Town Gymnasium, 7:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m. The Board of Civil Authority met on Wednesday, August 20, 2014 to update the checklist. All ballots and the checklist were posted in accordance with VSA Title 17 and the Barre Town Charter.

Election Day

OPENING OF THE POLLS

Presiding Officer Donna Kelty declared the polls open at 7:00 a.m. and declared closed at 7:00 p.m. There were no incidents to report. With this being the first day of school the Constable patrolled the parking lot during bus delivery and pick up of students.

STATISTICAL INFORMATION

The Primary Election ballots were counted using the Accuvote Optic Scan machine. All ballots were taken from the tabulator and reviewed to locate write-in votes. The write in votes were then tabulated by 2-member teams consisting of BCA members.

There are 5,463 voters on the checklist with 382 ballots cast (6.99 % voter turnout). Of those that voted 51 were early ballots. The final ballot count for the Primary Election is Democratic Party = 75 ballots; Progressive Party = 2 ballots; Liberty Union = 1 ballot, and Republican Party = 304 ballots.
