

**BARRE TOWN MIDDLE & ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DISTRICT ANNUAL MEETING
March 5, 2019**

The duly warned Barre Town Middle & Elementary School District Special revote by Australian ballot was held on Tuesday, March 5, 2019 at the Barre Town Gymnasium, 7:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m. The Board of Civil authority met on Thursday, February 28, 2019 to update the checklist.

POSTING CERTIFICATION

All advertising, postings, and meetings were administered in accordance with VSA Title 17 and the Town of Barre Charter Sections 3a and 6c. Advertising was through the Times Argus Newspaper and postings locations included: Hannaford's Market, Trow Hill Grocery, Graniteville General Store, Lawson's Store, the Barre Town Municipal Building, and the Town website.

Election Day

The following individuals worked at the polls on March 5, 2019: Donna J. Kelty, R. Lee Walther, Pearl Bugbee, William Bugbee, Jay Perkins, Sheila Walther, Virginia Poplawski, Shirley Rivard, Bob Gioria, Andrea Blanchard, Sandy Kirkland, and Ginny Perantoni.

Presiding Officer Donna Kelty declared the polls open at 7:00 a.m. The polls were declared closed at 7:00 p.m. On a side note the school gymnasium clock was 5 minutes slow. The opening of the polls was based on the cell phone clock and closing took place based on the school gymnasium clock.

The Town Meeting ballots were counted using the Accuvote Optic Scan machine. Two voters were added to the checklist on Monday afternoon after printing the checklist (Michele Lane and Richard Lester Lane Jr.). On Election day three additional voters were added (Laurie A. Pepin, Melissa P. Jensen and Zecor Berger). The total number of voters on the checklist after the additions is 5,774. There were 453 ballots cast (7.8 % voter turnout) with 83 of those being early ballots.
