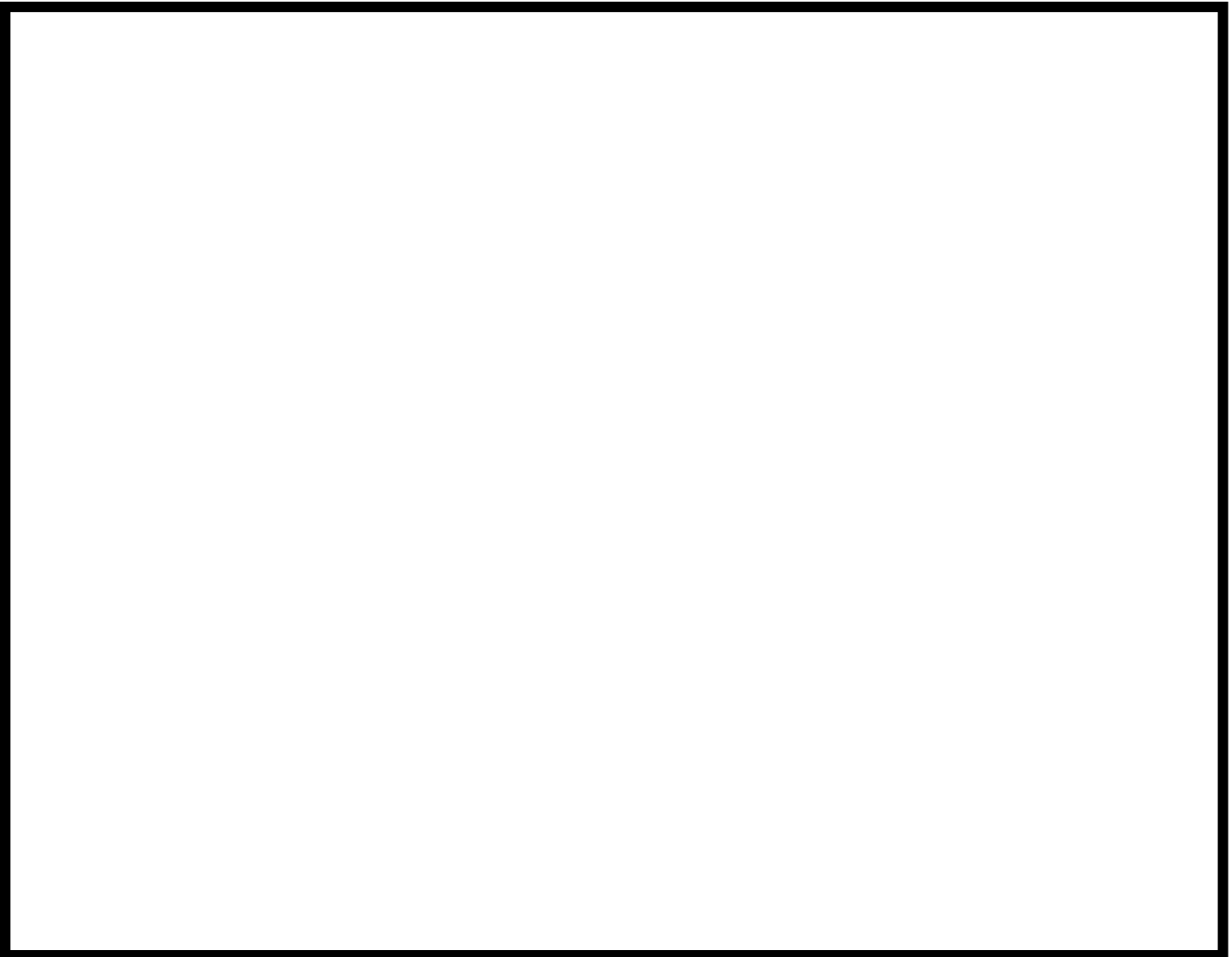

**NOTICE:**

- With input from the Barre Town Fire Chief, Chief of Police or their authorized designee(s), the Selectboard has the authority (by Vermont Statute and Barre Town policy) to deny or place restrictions on any application. Such denial or restriction will be written and attached hereto as an amendment of the application.
- The Selectboard may request the applicant/property owner publish a 3" x 4" advertisement in the Times Argus Newspaper or provide written notice to the general neighborhood as to when and where the fireworks display will take place. The advertisement or delivery of notices will be not less than 5 days prior to the scheduled display date.
- A copy of the approved application and/or amendment will be kept at the Fireworks Display site.
- Attached hereto are copies of Vermont Statutes Title 20, Sections 3131 thru 3135.

Sketch of Display Plan



The sketch will be a diagram of the grounds on which the fireworks display is to be held and should include but is not limited to: showing the point at which the fireworks are to be discharged, the location of all buildings, highways and other lines of communication, the lines behind which the audience will be restrained, and the location of all nearby trees, telegraph or telephone lines or other overhead obstruction.
