Selectboard 3-year term:

On a motion by Jeff Blow, seconded by Paul White, Justin Bolduc was nominated for Selectboard 3-year term.

With no other candidates the nominations were closed, and Moderator Koch declared Justin Bolduc the winner of the Selectboard 3-year term non-partisan caucus nomination.

Selectboard 2-year term:

On a motion by Rob LaClair, seconded by Donald Koch, Paul White was nominated for Selectboard 2-year term.

With no other candidates the nominations were closed, and Moderator Koch declared Paul White the winner of the Selectboard 2-year term non-partisan caucus nomination.

Auditor 3-year term:

On a motion by Donald Koch, seconded by Chris Neddo, Jeff Blow was nominated for Auditor 3-year term.

With no other candidates the nominations were closed, and Moderator Koch declared Jeff Blow the winner of the Auditor 3-year term non-partisan caucus nomination.

Constable 1-year term:

On a motion by Paul White, seconded by R. Lee Walther, David Freeman was nominated for Constable 1-year term.

With no other candidates the nominations were close, and Moderator Koch declared David Freeman the winner of the Constable 1-year term non-partisan caucus nomination.

Moderator 1-year term:

With no other candidates the nominations were closed, and Moderator Koch declared Thomas Koch the winner of the Moderator for a 1-year term non-partisan caucus nomination.
