PAYMENTS

MAIL-IN PAYMENTS

Payments must be postmarked by the USPS on or before the due date to avoid a penalty. Postage meter dates are not official postmarks.

Make checks payable to:

Be sure to:

Include 2026 General Payment Stub(s)
Write the account number on the check.

Make sure the check or money order is signed, dated, and written for the **correct amount**.

If you are paying in full by Tuesday, February 10th, please remember to take the one percent (1%) discount on the second-half amount, as indicated on your bill.

FOR E-CHECK OR CREDIT/DEBIT CARD

- Electronic checks: \$1.75 flat fee
- Credit cards: 2.3% of total amount
- Visa and Mastercard debit cards only: \$3.95 flat fee

Use the account number, excluding the "G", when searching for your bill. For example, for account number 12345-G only enter 12345 for your search.

New York Law requires individuals paying property taxes by credit card to pay transaction fees. These fees are paid directly to the third-party processor and not the Town of North Hempstead. The Town receives no profit from this service.

When paying with an online check through your bank, please include your account number exactly as shown on your tax bill (for example, 12345-G).

TAXES ARE NOT CONSIDERED PAID UNTIL YOUR PAYMENT HAS CLEARED THE BANK

If a bill is not received, it is the owner's responsibility to contact the tax office and request one. Under New York State Law, failure to receive a tax bill does not exempt the taxpayer from payment or penalties.

TAX OFFICE EXTENDED HOURS:

February 5 and 9 from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. and February 10 from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m.
 August 6 from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. and August 10 from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m.

You must pay with check or money order only at local tax collection sites.

Town Law mandates collection of a \$20.00 fee for any check returned as uncollected to the Receiver of Taxes Office.

DID YOU KNOW?

Payment Might Be Returned For The Following:

- Not including the 2026 payment stub
- Not including the account number, bill number, or parcel number on the check
- Not paying the exact amount due
- The “numerical and written” amounts don’t match
- Check is not signed
- Not writing your check in black or blue ink

If your check can’t be deposited or bounces and causes late payment, penalty charges will apply. No extra time will be granted.

Paying your Taxes from Outside of the United States:

- Access to the Town of North Hempstead website is blocked from anywhere outside of the US
- To pay your taxes online go directly to our online vendor **billpay.forte.net/northhempsteadgeneraltax**
- To pay via phone dial 011 (516) 869-7800 and select option #1

Avoid Potential Check Fraud:

- Pay online whenever possible. Use our online bill pay, e-check or IVR phone option
- If you mail a check, drop it inside your post office-not in a home mailbox or outdoor blue box
- Use a permanent (indelible) pen and fill out all lines completely
- Monitor your account and check images regularly
