

ORDINANCE NO.: 2018-10

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 15, CHAPTER 4, SECTION 15-401 OF THE TOWN OF SIGNAL MOUNTAIN MUNICIPAL CODE IN REFERENCE TO SPEED LIMITS.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated 55-8-153(C)(2) gives legislative authority to municipalities to establish special speed limits upon any highway or public road of this state within their jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, The Town of Signal Mountain believes it to be in the interest of public safety to establish these speed limits;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SIGNAL MOUNTAIN, TENNESSEE, THAT:


SECTION 1. Title 15, Chapter 4, Section 15-401 shall be deleted in its entirety and shall be replaced with the following language:

15-401. In general. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate or drive a motor vehicle upon any highway or street within the Town at a rate of speed in excess of twenty-five (25) miles per hour, except in those locations where official signs have been posted by the Town designating other speed limits which shall apply as follows:

- (1) US 127 / SR-8 throughout the Town shall have a posted speed limit of thirty-five (35) miles per hour.
- (2) The entire length of Timberlinks Drive, Shoal Creek Road, Shackleford Ridge Road, and the portion of James Boulevard (between and including the 800 and 1700 blocks), shall have a speed limit of thirty (30) miles per hour.
- (3) All school zones within the Town shall have a posted speed limit of fifteen (15) miles per hour and shall be in accordance with Section 15-403 of this Chapter. (1985 Code, 9-401, as replaced by Ord. #2005-1, Feb. 2005, as amended by Ord. #2007-9, May 2007)
