

Single-Stream Recycling

- Plastic #1 PETE and Plastic #2 HDPE
- Steel and aluminum (cans, pie trays, foil, etc.)
- Newspaper and mixed paper

These items no longer need to be sorted and can all be deposited together in the single-stream containers marked "In Use". When they are full, attendants will open others. Please rinse all food from containers before recycling. You may leave caps/lids on all single-stream items.

Glass is collected in a separate container. Please rinse all food from glass containers before recycling, remove caps/lids on all glass containers, and place only the glass in the container.

Cardboard will be compacted as usual. Because of the high volume received, the Town will continue to compact corrugated cardboard. Please remember to remove all packing material, plastic, and styrofoam from cardboard boxes before placing them into the machine. Please dispose of Styrofoam and plastic bags elsewhere.

E-Waste

- Computers, laptops, tablets, printers, and accessories
- Servers and networking equipment
- Flat screen LED/LCD TVs and monitors
- Cell phones, office phones, and house phones
- Cameras, remotes, routers, and modems
- Stereo equipment, record players, speakers, etc.
- DVD players, blu-ray players, and VCRs
- Video game consoles and accessories
- Air conditioners, microwaves, toasters, blenders, and other household electronics
- Cords, cables, chargers, etc.
- Batteries (NOT car batteries; those are accepted at the Transfer Station)

Hazardous Materials (Non-commercial householders only)

- Brake fluid
- Pool chemicals
- NON-LATEX Paint
- Spray paint
- Wood preservatives
- Paint thinner
- Solvents
- Adhesives
- Fertilizers
- Fungicides
- Herbicides
- Insecticides
- Pesticides
- Drain openers & polishers
- Household cleaners/oven cleaners
- Fire extinguishers
- Propane tanks
- Fluorescent bulbs
- Gasoline

Antifreeze, oil, car batteries, large appliances, and scrap metal will be accepted at the Transfer Station at 714 Mississippi Avenue.
