Commissioner Cook moved, seconded by Commissioner Moyzis to appoint Ryan Robinson to the rank of firefighter/paramedic pending the approval of the Board of Trustees to fill the vacancy and also on Ryan Robinson's successful completion of the pre-employment testing process. Roll call: All voted aye. Passed unanimously.

Fire Chief Zack Riddle attended the meeting and shared further details on his plans for an internship program in the fire department. Chief Riddle advised that it will be a three (3) year program for Oak Lawn residents. The Village will reimburse interns for their training based on performance during their internship. He anticipates that the program may be approved by the Board of Trustees in September.


The next regular meeting of the Board was scheduled for Wednesday, September 9, 2020, at 6:30 p.m.


The meeting was adjourned at 6:29 p.m.


