REGULAR MEETING MINUTES #22-04

Commissioner Rolence called the meeting to order at 6:50 p.m.

The Board reviewed the minutes from their last meeting. Commissioner Henehan moved, seconded by Commissioner Cook to approve Regular Meeting Minutes 22-03 dated Wednesday, March 16, 2022. Roll Call: All voted aye. Passed unanimously.

The Board reviewed Commendation Certificates for the following members of the Oak Lawn Police Department: Officer Olsson, Officer Malachowski, Sgt. Kirk, Officer Lackey, Officer Doyle, Officer Atkinson, Officer Harland, Officer Dunn, Officer O'Shea and Officer Bess.

The Board reviewed Honorable Mention Certificates for the following members of the Oak Lawn Police Department: Officer Williams, Officer Atkinson, Officer Carroll, Officer Lupa, Officer Hernandez, Officer Shilney, Officer Daddona and Officer Jachymiak.

Approval of Invoices:

- A. Trans Union Corporation Invoice No. 032002090 dated March 25, 2022 in the amount of \$233.95 for our regular monthly fee and candidate credit reports.
- B. Ergo Metrics Invoice No. 141859 dated March 31, 2022 in the amount of \$392.60 for the Firefighter/Paramedic Written examination material rental.
- C. Proven Invoices No. 0004 dated April 7, 2022 in the amount of \$1,186 for pre-employment physicals for Brian Flisk and Daniel Rehder.
- D. Odelson, Sterk, Murphey, Frazier & McGrath, Ltd. Invoice No. 33502 dated April 14, 2022 in the amount of \$693.75 for legal services rendered through March 31, 2022.

Commissioner Baker moved, seconded by Commissioner Henehan, to approve the above listed invoices. Roll call: All voted aye. Passed unanimously.

The Board is still in the process of creating a new Firefighter/Paramedic Eligibility List since the previous list was exhausted. The Board conducted interviews for eligible candidates prior to the meeting this evening. Once a list is posted, there will be six vacancies to be filled immediately from prior requests.

Ms. Borgman has been working with Chief Riddle to add additional resources to the reading list for the rank of Fire Engineer. Ms. Borgman will also work with Resource Management Associates and NIPSTA to set dates for the different components. Ms. Borgman will also ask Chief Riddle to arrange to use Tinley Park's training facility for the practical portion of the testing process.

The Board discussed the status of Chief Vittorio's request to hire eight (8) new police patrol officers in the police department. Commissioner Moyzis moved, seconded by Commissioner Baker to ratify the removal of candidates 17 & 23 from the police patrol officer eligibility list. . Roll call: All voted aye. Passed unanimously. Commissioner Cook moved, seconded by Commissioner Crosby to ratify the hiring of Mia Sanchez, Liam Kelly, Daniel Rehder and Brian Flisk effective May 2, 2022. . Roll call: All voted aye. Passed unanimously. Both Mia Sanchez and Liam Kelly will be attending the Basic Police Recruit Academy – Cook County. Officers Rehder and Flisk are already certified and will begin the department's field training program. Due to multiple candidates withdrawing from the process, the eligibility list was exhausted before filling all eight (8) vacancies. The four (4) remaining vacancies will be filled from a new list once established.

The Board discussed the upcoming testing process for patrol officer. At this time, there will not be any changes made to the testing requirements. Ms. Borgman will send the commissioners a copy of advertising for their review and feedback.


Commissioner Rolence reminded all of the commissioners to complete their Cook County non-disclosure certification. Many of the commissioners commented that they had recently completed their certification.

The Board discussed and confirmed that they would like to request the Board of Trustees to change the Fire & Police Commissions regular meeting date to the 3rd Wednesday of each month and 6:30 p.m.


The next regular meeting of the Board was scheduled for Wednesday, May 18, 2022 at 6:30 p.m.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Commissioner Crosby moved, seconded by Commissioner Baker, to adjourn the meeting. Roll call: All voted aye. Passed unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:24 p.m.


