REGULAR MEETING MINUTES #22-05

Commissioner Rolence called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

The Board reviewed the minutes from their last meeting. Commissioner Henehan moved, seconded by Commissioner Cook to approve Regular Meeting Minutes 22-04 dated Thursday, April 14, 2022. Roll Call: All voted aye. Passed unanimously.

Approval of Invoices:

- A. Trans Union Corporation Invoice No. 04200285 dated April 25, 2022 in the amount of \$95.00 for our regular monthly fee.
- B. Proven Invoices No. No. 0006 dated May 9, 2022, in the amount of \$1,296 for pre-employment physicals for Mia Sanchez and Liam Kelly.

Commissioner Cook moved, seconded by Commissioner Crosby, to approve the above listed invoices. Roll call: All voted aye. Passed unanimously.

The Firefighter/Paramedic Final Eligibility List was posted on May 6, 2022. There are eleven (11) candidates on the list. Ms. Borgman has contacted the first six (6) candidates and asked them to complete their fingerprinting. The rest of the candidates will complete theirs next week. CLS Enterprises will be starting background investigations on everyone. Chief Riddle has six (6) openings that he needs filled.

An orientation for Fire Engineer is scheduled for Thursday, May 19, 2022 in the Auditorium. The practical exam is scheduled for Monday, June 13, 2022 at the Tinley Park Fire Department. In the

event of rain the practical will be moved to Thursday, June 16, 2022. The written examination is scheduled for Wednesday, July 27, 2022. There are two candidates participating in the process and two vacancies to be filled once an eligibility list is posted and it will in turn become exhausted.


Applications are being taken for the position of police patrol officer from now until Friday, June 3, 2022. Applications are available on the lower-level of the Municipal Center. An additional advertisement will be placed on the website GoLawEnforcement.com. Ms. Borgman stated that she received an inquiry regarding the maximum age for officers with experience. Attorney Horvath confirmed that the only exception to the age requirement was for military applicants who receive one additional year for each year served up to ten (10) years. Through their home rule powers, when Oak Lawn adopted the age requirement they did not allow for any of the exemptions for current officers. Once an eligibility list is posted, there will be four (4) vacancies to be filled.

The Board reviewed a request from Chief Vittorio to promote one (1) lieutenant and one (1) sergeant in the police department. Commissioner Henehan moved, seconded by Commissioner Crosby to appoint Michael Hudziak to the rank of Police Lieutenant effective May 24, 2022. Roll call: All voted aye. Passed unanimously. Commissioner Cook moved seconded by Commissioner Moyzis to appoint Finbar Haran to the rank of Sergeant effective May 24, 2022. Roll call: All voted aye. Passed unanimously.


The next regular meeting of the Board was scheduled for Wednesday, June 15, 2022 at 6:30 p.m.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Commissioner Moyzis moved, seconded by Commissioner Cook, to adjourn the meeting. Roll call: All voted aye. Passed unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:02 p.m.




Al Moyzis, Member (District 1)



Robert Cook, Member (District 3)




