REGULAR MEETING MINUTES #23-01

The Board reviewed the minutes from their last meeting. Commissioner Egan moved, seconded by Commissioner Moyzis to approve Regular Meeting Minutes 22-12 dated Wednesday, December 21, 2022. Roll Call: All voted aye. Passed unanimously.

The Board reviewed the following invoices:

Commissioner Rolence advised the advertisement for entry firefighter/paramedic will be published soon, and that applications are being made into PDF fillable forms so that candidates have an online option for obtaining applications.

Commissioner Rolence advised there is no police testing as of now, and that there are two names left on the list.

Commissioner Egan made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Baker, to keep the election of officers at status quo. Roll call: All voted aye. Passed unanimously.

Commissioner Rolence announced that the February meeting will be held on February 1, 2023, and confirmed that all meetings will be held on the first Wednesday of every month.

Jeff Kane, President – IAFF Local 3405 commented that he would like the clarification of retroactivity time to promotions that were made, and the impact it has on Engineer Keith Giles. 




