III. APPROVAL OF PRIOR MEETING MINUTES:

A.) TC-1280-M – Request for Residential Permit Parking Only on the West Side of Central Avenue between 88th Street and 89th Street:

Petitioner was not present at the meeting.

A motion was made by Member Lupescu to table Pet. #TC-1280-M-Request for residential permit parking only on the west side of Central Avenue between 88th Street and 89th Street. The motion was seconded by Member Grady.

V. NEW BUSINESS:

A.) TC-1281-M – Request for “No Parking Anytime” Signs on the North and South Sides of 103rd Street between Central Avenue and Major Avenue:

Dennis Skoda, Oak Lawn Department of Public Works

Mr. Skoda introduced the request to the Committee. Member Sochacki asked if the signs were already installed. Mr. Skoda stated the proposed signs would be for no parking along 103rd St. He said that 103rd St. is 4 lanes and does not have no parking signs currently similar to the 103rd St. east of Central Ave. Mr. Skoda stated that there were cars parking on the subject street in the summer and caused issues. He continued that tickets need to be issued and no parking signs were needed in order to do that. Mr. Skoda was not sure if there were signs up in the years past or not. He described 103rd St. west of Major Ave. being 2 lanes, which was narrowed down from 4 lanes at some point.

Member Grady asked if there were 2 lanes with 1 lane of parking. She stated that there is no parking past Major Ave. Mr. Skoda said that the request was to install the signs between Central Ave. and Major Ave.

Member Sochacki asked what types of signed would be installed. Mr. Skoda responded that the signs will be “No Parking Anytime.” He continued that the new signs were already installed and that if the petition was denied by the Committee they could be removed. The signs would need to also be approved by the Board.

A motion was made by Member Skoundrianos to approve Pet. #TC-1281-M-Request for “No Parking Anytime” signs on the north and south sides of 103rd Street between Central Avenue and Major Avenue. The motion was seconded by Member Sochacki.
