# Trash Collection, Recycling & Yard Waste

RESIDENTIAL trash collection service in West Deer Township is MANDATORY.

The West Deer Township Boad of Supervisors awarded the current weekly residentail solid waste and bi-weekly recyclable material collection contract to:

Office hours are 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m., Monday - Friday.

Shank Waste Service collects every holiday except for New Year's Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Memorial Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.

#### Trash Collection:

- 1) Trash must be at the curb (within five feet of the road where the truck travels) on your collection day no later than 6:00 a.m.
- 2) All trash should be bagged, boxed, bundled, or contained in some manner. Each parcel should weigh no more than 40-50 pounds. Cans or bag sizes should not exceed 32 gallons.
- 3) Shank Waste Service will not accept the following: Dirt, sod, rocks, bricks, cement, building materials, remodeling materials, auto parts, hazardous waste, paint or anything containing freon (refrigerators, air conditioners, etc.).

No televisions, computers or propane tanks are accepted either. Pennsylvania law states that televisions, computers, monitors, printers and keyboards must be recycled. If you have any of these items bring them to the Hard-To-Recycle drive-thru event on May 24 (see back page for details).
