# BEWARE OF SCAMS

*People claiming to represent the I.R.S., other government agencies, or charitable organizations are calling residents in an effort to get money!*

---

When receiving calls from strangers asking for donations, beware of these warning signs:

- Make vague claims about a cause.
- Use a name similar to a well-known organization.
- Provide little or no detailed information.
- Refuse to answer questions.
- Refuse to provide a call-back number.
- Use a “spoofed” phone number.
- Demand immediate payment.
- Ask for payment via wire transfer or prepaid card.
- Ask for payment to an individual instead of an organization.
