Thanks to all of our great seniors who came out to hear Mike Emrich from Bartlett Tree Experts and Councilwoman Vicki Miller talk about tree care and WHISPER respectively. They both provided great insight to their passions and we left with some great information to tackle our “Spring Clean Up” dilemmas. I was happy to provide information to our seniors, too, on the County’s new budgeting program for property taxes, Homestead Tax Exemption, Water credit (we are not eligible for the sewer portion since we are serviced by Euclid, not Lake County Department of Utilities for that service!) and Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP). If you did not attend the luncheon, but would like information on these programs, please reach out to Gloria at 440-951-0776.

The Lake County Planning & Community Development Program has just recently announced their “Lead Safe Ohio Program” which is geared toward addressing free home and facility repairs, lead-based paint prevention & mitigation for pre-1978 structures. It is being offered to homeowners & renters who meet income qualifications and owner/operators of congregate shelters & childcare facilities. The eligibility amount is \$50,000 per unit (residential limit) and \$100,000 per facility limit. Eligible items include window and door replacement, siding, soffit and fascia enclosure, porch component repair and other supportive measures. Thanks, too, to Chris Gumal and Holly Ferkol of our Library Staff who were on hand to offer us seed packets for spring planting. They have asked to come back next month to continue to offer this nice gesture.



OUR SPRING CLEANING CONTINUES...

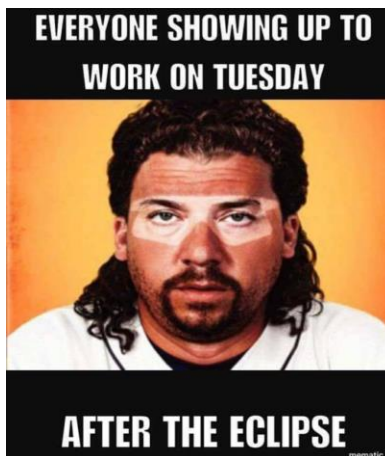
