MAYOR GARDNER'S REPORT:

Happy New Year to all! I am very excited about everything that will be happening in Willoughby Hills in 2023.

As you will see in the following pages, the Recreation Commission has already started planning a full slate of activities for the new year. Please be sure to mark Sunday, March 5th on your calendar for the City's annual Pancake Breakfast. Also, the 2023 Photo Contest categories have been announced and are as follows: *Working in Willoughby Hills, Go Green, Windows and Glass, and Fundamentally Family*.

In addition to the Recreation Commission programs, the Mayor's office will be continuing our Trivia Night in Willoughby Hills program (3rd Tuesday of every month) and, once again, we are planning to compete in the Mind Challenge Trivia competition for those 50 and over against teams from other area communities. Anyone that is interested in participating in our trivia programs should contact the Mayor's office for details.

Although not on the calendar yet, the City will be hosting shredding days and electronics recycling days. We are coordinating the dates for these events with the vendors and we will let you know the dates and times as soon as they have been scheduled.

The Police and Fire departments will be presenting programs throughout the year for our residents and businesses including Safety Town, Touch-a-Truck, and crime prevention programs.

Last week, the Fire Department took delivery of its new Command Truck/EMS Chase Vehicle. This Vehicle responds to almost every incident in the City and is a critical part of the Department's operations. Over the next several weeks it will be up-fitted with its radios, electronics, emergency lights and other equipment. We plan to have it on the road serving you by the end of February. In addition, we have been told the construction of our new first-out fire engine will be starting in the coming months. We expect delivery by the end of the summer and that you will be able to see it at Touch-a-Truck in September.

Finally, if you need to start looking forward to Spring: the Willoughby Hills Youth Sports League Is accepting registration for the 2023 Softball and Baseball seasons. Team practices will begin early/mid April and games start in May. Here is the link to register:

WELCOME TO OUR NEW FULL-TIME POLICE OFFICER

Officer Leonbruno joins the department with 10 years of police experience, most recently as a full time police officer in Madison Township.

Willoughby Hills Fire Rescue took delivery of a 2022 Ford F-250 crew cab pickup truck. The vehicle was actually ordered over a year ago in October of 2021. It was slated for delivery in February of 2022, but did not arrive until December 29th of 2022. This will replace our 2012 Ford Expedition that just hit over 100,000 miles. It is expected to be in service in about two months after an array of equipment, accessories, warning lights, graphics and radios are installed. The pickup truck concept for command vehicles has been gaining popularity over the years throughout the U.S. It allows for better isolation of potentially carcinogen contaminated gear and equipment to be isolated from the occupants of the vehicle.
